GENERAL CONDITIONS

The **Godella International Talented Young Chamber Musicians Competition** aims to contribute to the training of young players, as well as to creating a platform for their professionalisation and promotion on the classical music circuit.

The competition specialises in the chamber music repertoire and is aimed at chamber groups comprising a minimum of 3 musicians.

Instruments from the string, woodwind, brass, voice and piano families are welcomed.

The competition is open to players of all nationalities.

First Prize winners from previous festivals may not take part.

The average age of group members may not exceed 26 on the day of the competition. As a minimum, applicants should be in at their first year of degree-level music studies.

REGISTRATION PROCESS

Please register on-line using the form provided on the competition website: www.musicacambragodella.es. Any registration that is not correctly filled out will be rejected.

The deadline for registration is 28 June 2019.

Entry fees:

Chamber groups with 3 members: 30€ per participant (90€)

Chamber groups with 4 or more members: 150€ per group.

Payment should be made by bank transfer to the following account:

* Proof of payment must be attached to the registration form in .pdf format.

Should the number of registrations admitted not exceed the stipulated minimum, the organisation reserves the right to cancel the competition.

Registration for the competition implies full acceptance of these entry conditions.

The list of selected participants will be displayed on the competition website from 8 July 2019. If an application for registration is not accepted, registration fees will be returned by bank transfer.

The Organising Committee will select participants on the basis of musical quality. Participants attending the competition for the first time will take priority.

AUDITIONS

Auditions will take place at the Capitolio Theatre in Godella.

The competition has two rounds: the first round and the final, both public.

First round: Thursday 25 July 2019

Final: Friday 26 July 2019

Each of the chamber groups will come with a prepared repertoire of 2-3 works in different styles, lasting a maximum of 35 minutes.

In the first round, each group will have a maximum of 20 minutes to play up to 2 partial or complete works in different styles.

The finalists may play all their repertoire presented for the competition.

Participants will play in alphabetical order.

Players should be present at least 15 minutes before each of the rounds. If players do not appear when called to perform, they will be understood to have forfeited their right to participate.

The jury shall be provided with a copy of the parts of the chosen works if they so request.

The jury reserves the right to request the performance of only part of the works presented or interrupt them as they consider appropriate.

The organisation reserves the right to record the competition and broadcast it via any audiovisual medium. Participants waive any rights they may have on these grounds.

When the competition comes to an end, following the jury's deliberation, the result will be announced and the prizes awarded.

Any matters not covered in these entry conditions will be resolved by the Organising Committee in agreement with the jury. All decisions are final.

The jury will be considered duly constituted even in the absence of one of its members. The organisation reserves the right to substitute any member of the jury if required, as well as the right to award the prizes jointly and the right to leave them unawarded if considered appropriate.

PRIZES

First Prize: cash prize of 1,500€ + one year's representation by a management agency.

Second Prize: a promotional campaign that includes: a concert during the season of concerts prior to the Godella Chamber Music Festival + recording of a music video + a photographic session + a featured article in Melómano magazine.

Prize-winners will receive a certificate attesting to their win.

Where a prize is awarded jointly the winners will share the prize equally.

Failure to attend the prize-giving without due justification will imply forfeit of the prize by the winner.
